## NUT AND EGG FREE

Gingerbread (loaf or muffins)

125g butter  
3/4 cup of sugar  
1 tbsp. of ginger  
1 cup of warmed milk  
1/1/2 tsp of baking soda  
2 tbsp. of golden syrup  
2 cups of flour  
Pinch of salt.

Melt butter, sugar and golden syrup. Warm milk and soda, then add to butter mixture. Sift in dry ingredients and mix. Bake at 180c for 45 minutes or 20 mins for muffins
